Some suggested changes:

- Pair Provisional with upper year member to mentor.
- Increase GIVE requirements to 6-8 hours. Big group GIVE project instead of volunteering individually
 - Have members work on Saturdays & host First Fridays at RE. Full time manager needed at RE.
 - Increase cookbook credits.
- Summer mandatory social event so Prov. will get to know other members before meeting in Sept.
- Larger PR committee & more community outreach. Monthly newsletters to donors using Gala lists.
 - Host smaller fundraisers like 5k, Rustic Cuff/Kendra Scott Giveback events.
 - Need members to interact more frequently with our social media pages.
 - Use remind 101/text software to send out information to members.
 - Establish a clear financial policy.
 - Better passing of the torch/passing on of information from previous years.
- Lack of attendance at social events. Positive feedback on increased social opportunities this year.
